# **Summer Safety Reminders for Residents**

As children begin their summer break, please help us keep our neighborhood safe and enjoyable for everyone:

# **Drive Safely**

Kids are out of school—kids will be outside more often, playing and riding bikes. Please observe all speed limits and watch carefully for children at play.

# Safety Reminder for Children

Please remind all children to stop and look both ways before entering any parking lot or roadway.

# **Respect Mailboxes**

Remind children not to climb, shake, or insert objects into mailboxes, locks, or mail slots.

## **Stay Clear of Drainage Areas**

For safety, please ensure children do not play in or near the drainage tubes that run from the road to the drainage fields. These areas are not safe play zones.

# **Put Away Toys & Sports Equipment**

Please remove toys, sports equipment and toddler pools from your yards <u>each evening</u> to keep the community neat and safe for mowing and foot traffic.

# No Bikes or Scooters in Parking Areas

Do not leave bikes, scooters, or toys in parking lots—they can create hazards for vehicles and pedestrians.

# **UTILITIES – Cable, PECO & Verizon Boxes**

Please ensure that children do not play near or tamper with utility boxes, including those for cable, PECO, and Verizon. These boxes contain important and potentially hazardous equipment.

# **VIOLATION NOTICE SCHEDULE**

To ensure all residents are aware and have the time to correct any issues, the following schedule is followed for community violations unless urgent action is required:

1st Notice – "Friendly Reminder" (30 Days to Comply) A notice will be sent, giving 30 days

**2<sup>nd</sup> Notice** – Official Reminder (15 Days to Comply). If the issue is not resolved, a second notice is issued with a 15 Day deadline.

#### 3rd Notice - Final Notice and Fine -

to correct the issue.

Continued non-compliance will result in a final notice and the issuance of a fine as per community policy.

#### **FIREWORKS**

The use of fireworks is strictly prohibited. Sparklers are exempt from this; however, users must collect all wires and dispose of them properly. Failure to do so, WILL result in immediate fines (\$100 per occurrence), and authorities will be contacted without prior warning or further notice.



# **NO SOLICITING**

Soliciting within our community is strictly prohibited—regardless of whether the individual has a township permit. We are a private community. If a solicitor refuses to leave after being asked, please contact Caln Township Police for assistance.





# **SERVICE BOXES**

Please report any damaged service boxes to the property manager. Be sure to include the exact location when reporting.



#### **RECREATIONAL VEHICLES**

Any motorized recreational vehicle on Wedgwood private or common property is prohibited. This includes dirt bikes, ATV's, dune buggies, go-karts, snowmobiles, motorized bicycles, golf carts and other similar motorized or electric vehicles. This restriction is in place regardless of the type of motorized recreational vehicle or the intent of use.



#### **HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENTS**

Household Hazardous Waste, which describes a variety of substances, can not be disposed of in our regular trash or drains. The nearest event will take place on **Friday**, **June 20** at the CCIU in Coatesville and Sunday, **October 5** at Downingtown Middle School. You must pre-register online. #### STREETLIGHT OUTAGE

If you notice a streetlight outage in the community, please email the property manager with the following information:

- Street name
- Exact location of the light (e.g., near which address or landmark)
- Pole number
- Issue type does not turn on, flickers or not constantly on

Once reported, the contractor will be contacted to schedule the necessary repairs. **Note:** Some lights may reset automatically within 24 hours. We will monitor the situation and take appropriate action to ensure the issue is resolved.

# **NOTICE - SWIMMING & TODDLER POOLS**

Pools other than small plastic toddler pools are prohibited in Wedgwood. Toddler pools are to be emptied and put away daily. You may join our community pool by visiting our website at – wedgwoodestates.com/pool/
